



Do the pictures and words match?






Stretch the word out.

Determine the Persuade for hform author's purpose. Entertain




Listen to fluent, expressive reading.

Adjust your reading rate depending on the text.





Use word parts to determine the meaning of unknown words. un = not





Ask someone to define a word for you.

Use a thesaurus to find synonyms and antonyms.






