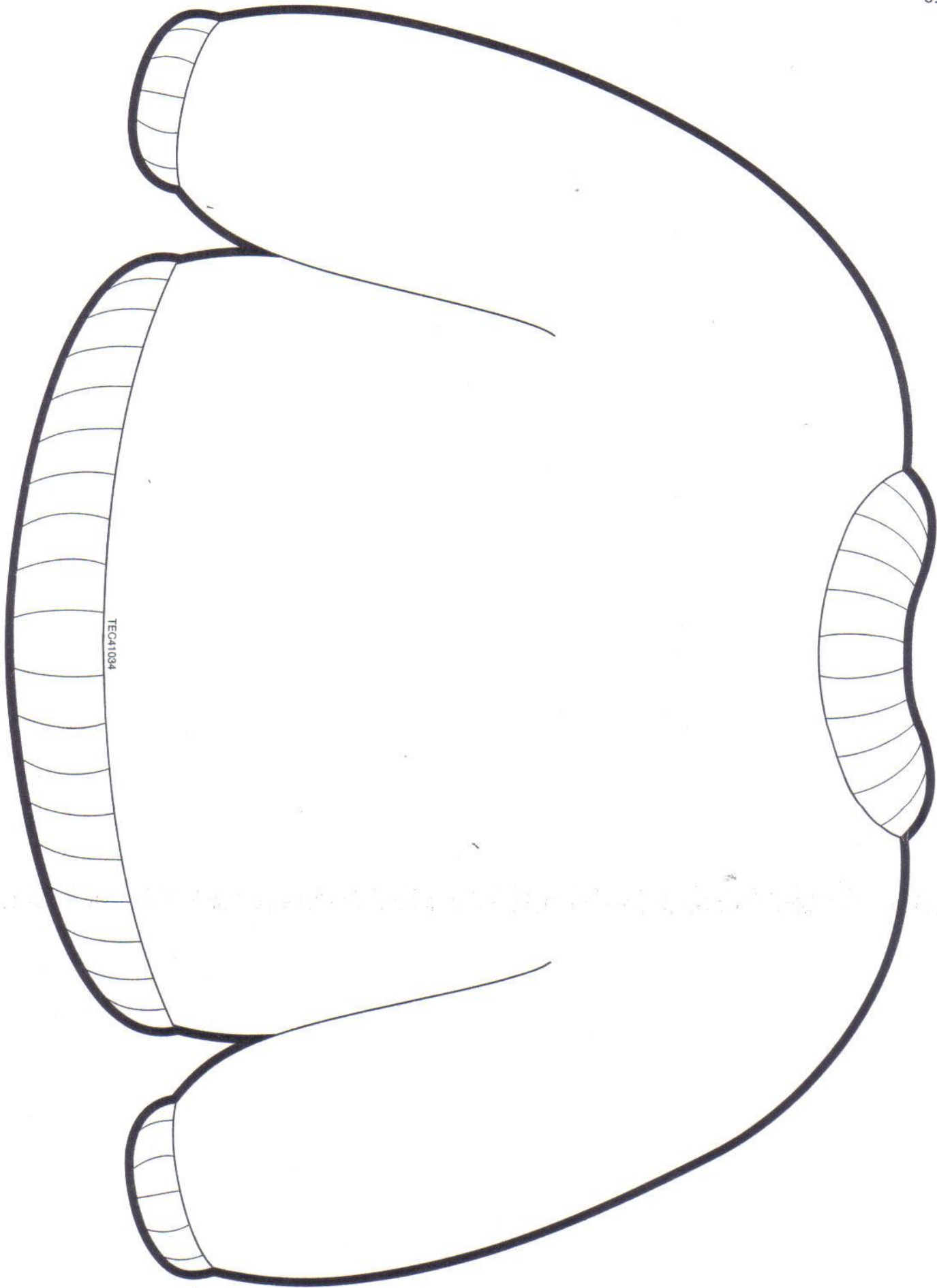


SWEATER math match-up

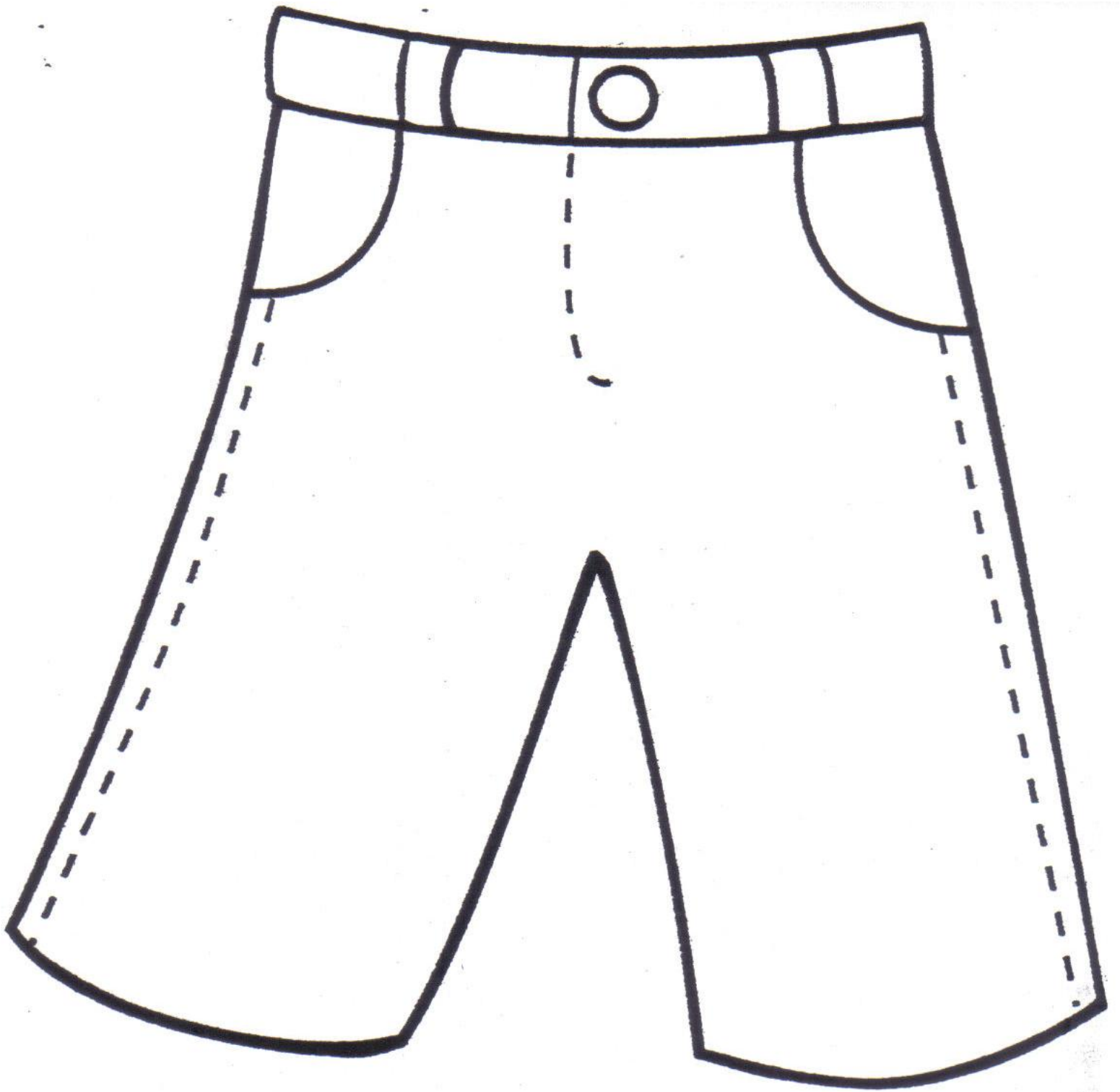


TO MAKE: Run the sweater pattern on 10 colors of paper. Add dots to the sweaters for students to count. (You could use stickers, die-cuts, etc.) Run the jean pattern on blue and add the numbers to match the dots on the sweaters.

TO PLAY: Students will count the dots on the sweater and find the matching pair of jeans and then hang them on a clothesline. I hung yarn on the back of a shelf in my classroom to make my clothesline.
