# TOP IT! GAME

{3 Addend Addition Partner Game}

## Teacher Directions

This is a fun game for kiddos to explore adding three addends.

Laminate the following cards. This game is played like {war}.

Have students stack the cards in the middle of them. Each student will turn 3 cards over and add the numbers together. The partner with the highest sum gets all of the cards. When the cards run out, the student with the most cards wins!  
{odd number cards are pink, even number cards are brown!}

This activity supports the Common Core Standard:

1.OA.6 – Add and subtract within 20

{creating equivalent but easier or known sums}

Have fun!

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Materials needed: Laminated cards

## Directions

Stack all the cards.

Put the cards in a pile in the middle of you and your partner.

Each player will turn 3 cards over.

Add the numbers together.

The partner with the highest sum get the cards.

Turn 3 more cards over.

When the cards run out, the student with the most cards wins!
